	<b>Branch Alliance for Educator Diversity (BranchED) Data Coach</b>
Organizational Description	<p>More than half of American public-school students are children of color, and only 18% of their teachers are from these same racial and ethnic groups. The Branch Alliance for Educator Diversity (BranchED) was founded in 2017 to empower, connect, and advance Minority Serving Institutions (HBCUs, HSIs, tribal colleges, and others) to maximize programming and drive innovation in preparing highly-effective educators who reflect and champion the diversity of our nation’s school children. These 290 Minority Serving Institutions (MSIs) comprise 14% of education providers in the United States but prepare 46% of our nation’s teachers of color.</p> <p>BranchED is the first and only non-profit organization in the nation that is dedicated to strengthening and growing educator preparation at MSIs, with the larger goals of both diversifying the teaching profession and intentionally addressing critical issues of educational equity for all students. BranchED has three goals that guide its work:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Empower:</b> working together to strengthen and grow MSI educator preparation programs by providing capacity building support that enhances MSI capabilities</li> <li>• <b>Connect:</b> strengthening relationships among MSIs by building partnerships to spur collaboration and innovation</li> <li>• <b>Advance:</b> amplifying a collective voice and advocating for shared interests by promoting awareness of educator diversity and championing MSIs</li> </ul>
Position Objective	<p>The Data Coach (DC) serves and communicates with multiple levels of stakeholders who are part of our National Educator Preparation Transformation Center. The DC functions as facilitator, consultant, and mentor, providing specialized coaching, development, and technical support to MSIs focused on building and implementing effective data management and usage, and transitioning from a culture of compliance to a culture of inquiry. The DC will also collaborate with the data analyst to manage various collection and analysis processes using data from MSIs to inform program technical support and research opportunities associated with BranchED.</p>
Essential Functions –	<p><b>Program Implementation</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Lead data reporting and assessment alignment sessions designed to support MSIs with establishing and implementing effective data use for EPP programming.</li> </ul>



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- Support all MSIs in the coaching cohorts with establishing and effectively using data to support continuous improvement planning/transformation plans.
- Conduct diagnostic, formative, and summative assessments aligned with BranchED's Quality Framework and communicate findings and recommendations via written reports and presentations:

  - o Data Empowerment
  - o Inclusive Pedagogy
  - o Practice Based Approach
  - o Intersectional Content
  - o Equitable Experiences
- Document services provided, assessment results, and collaborate with other Continuous Improvement Coaches in supporting entire scope of MSIs
- Utilize systems and tools to ensure proper documentation, measurement, and accessibility
- Assist on program effectiveness analysis and use outcomes to continuously improve internal program design
- Working knowledge of statistics
- Exceptional technical writing skills

## **Data Collection and Monitoring**

- Ensure data collection and reporting methods are accurate, effective and efficient
- Lead data collection, entry, and validation practices and procedures for MSIs.

## **Data Sharing & Reporting**

- Develop and collaborate on data presentations and contributions, inclusive of a variety of audience-appropriate data visuals for internal and external audiences, including diverse evaluation and higher education research entities, for all programming and services offered by BranchED

## **Other**

- Support the program team with identifying data sources, calculating baselines, setting targets, benchmark goals, etc.
- Support the program team with assuring technical assistance programs are developed based on researched, evidence-based practices
- Consult the program team on technical assistance and training for EPP's on effective data use and empowerment
- Along with BranchED's leadership team, helps develop and contribute to the organizational culture and values
