Dr. Sasha Rabkin



Dr. Sasha Rabkin brings over 20 years of experience in K-12 settings along with deep experience in grassroots community organizing, racial equity and social justice.

Sasha joined EOS in 2013 as a Partnership Director and served for five years as Chief Program Officer. During his tenure as CPO, EOS grew from 42 schools to over 350, built and launched the Action for Equity multi-phase model, generated \$35 million in earned revenue and established partnerships in over 30 states. In Fall 2019, Sasha built and launched a new Strategy Department at EOS and became the first EOS Chief Strategy Officer.

Prior to joining EOS, Sasha served for over eleven years, as Director of School and Family Programs at the Institute for Community Leadership where he managed a literacy and poetry based social justice leadership program with schools and families. Sasha is also a founder of the Jack Hunter O'Dell Education and Reflection Center. Prior to this, Sasha spent three years at the Washington State Office of Superintendent of Public Instructions where he managed statewide youth leadership and service learning programs.

Sasha has a Bachelor of Arts in Government from the University of Redlands, where he also served as student body president. He received his Doctorate in Educational Leadership and Change from Fielding Graduate University in Santa Barbara, CA.
