## Adelante - Candidates as in- and out-of-class equity agents. They: ...

- 1. create opportunities to access our program, work hard to ensure success in our program, and bring a can-do attitude when addressing the challenges of being a first-generation student in our program.
- 2. serve as pedagogical partners for our faculty and peer mentors for our candidates to ensure the success and retention of our future teachers.
- 3. include six national Educator Rising Collegiate champions, who began their journey to nationals at TAMIU.

## Juntos - Faculty create a unique ethic of care. They: ...

- 1. share a vision of success characterized by respecting language and culture, sharing responsibility for all candidates, and promoting a step-by-step (*paso-a-paso*) approach to success and mobility.
- 2. value of language and culture by lining our corridors with the wisdom or *dichos* of elders who provide our candidates with constant reminders of how to achieve the success they desire.
- 3. embrace a shared responsibility for all to the level of knowing every candidate by name and need, an approach that has contributed to success rates for our candidates (90+%) that far exceed the State benchmarks (75%) and have resulted in State commendation for the last three years.

## Sí Se Puede – Students, Faculty and Staff build relationships for fostering personal development and social adjustment. They: ...

- 1. create community spaces in our building to foster a sense of belonging in the college, to the profession and in the community to decrease feelings of isolation, increase levels of support, and promote persistence among our candidates.
- 2. provide enrichment activities to extend learning opportunities beyond the regularly scheduled class time.
- 3. Our *Si Se Puede!* Scholars receive the structure, strategies and sanctuary they need to experience success from admission through to graduation. Fall 2022 resulted in:
  - 1. 95% of our Scholars continue to be active in Certify Teacher and/or 240 Tutoring programs
  - 2. 20% are moving closer to securing permission to take the State exam
  - 3. 40 % have qualified to take the State exam
  - 4. 15 % have taken the State exam and are awaiting results
  - 5. 25% have passed their State exam
