

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Triangulation of Data Definition

Triangulation of data refers to the use of

multiple sources, methods, investigators, or theoretical perspectives to validate research findings and ensure the accuracy and reliability of data.

> Decreases the reliance of isolated data points in data decisions.





Triangulation of Data

- Triangulating data increases validity, fosters collaborative insights, and uncovers actionable trends

 - Data Interpretation Sessions
 - Collaborative Goal-Setting
 - Action Planning
